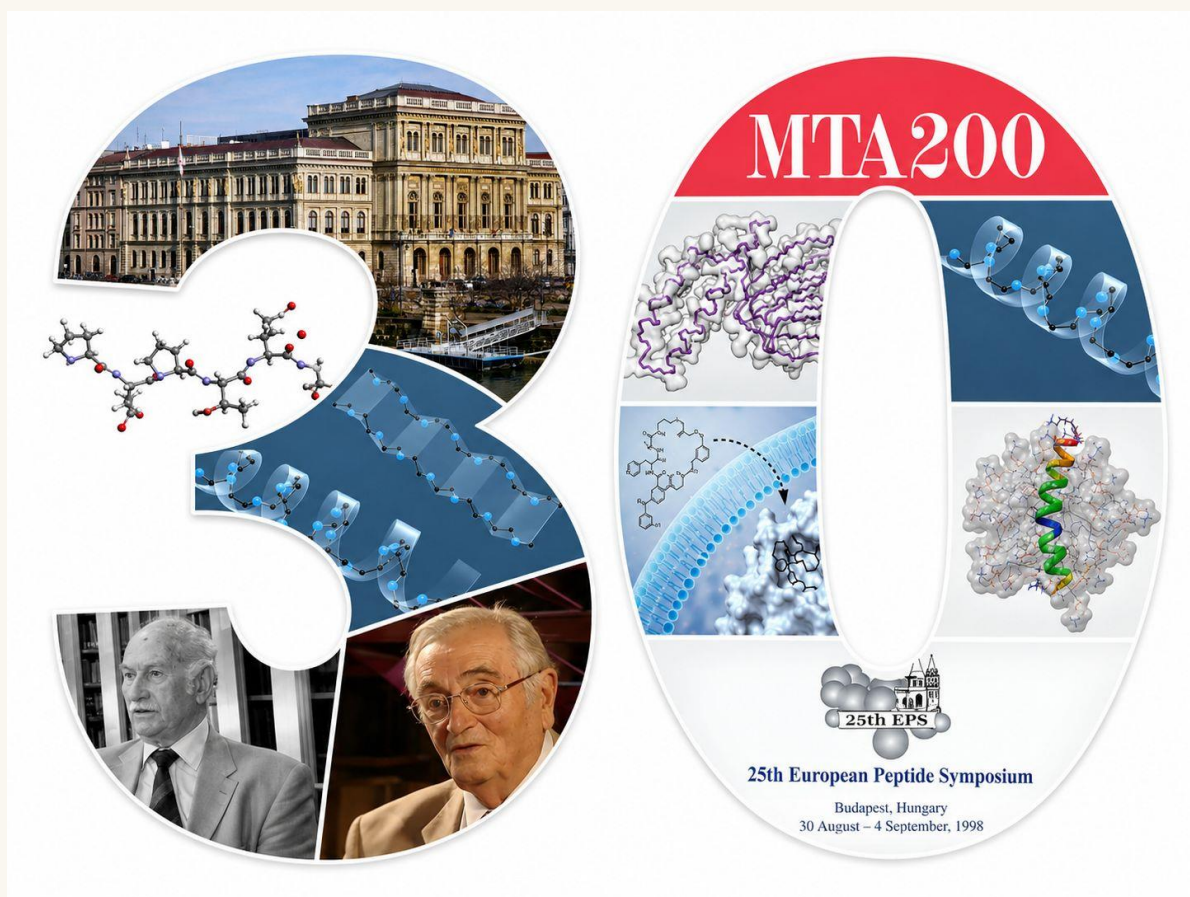


Foundation for the Hungarian Peptide and Protein Research JUBILEE SCIENTIFIC MEETING



The Board of Trustees of the Foundation for the Hungarian Peptide and Protein Research will organize a jubilee scientific meeting on 22 September 2026 (10:00-13:30) in the Great Hall of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. The event marks the Foundation's 30th anniversary and the 200th anniversary of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, founded in 1825, and will be held as part of the Chemistry Month lecture series.

The invited keynote speaker is **Fernando Albericio**, an internationally recognized peptide chemist.

The programme will feature young Hungarian researchers, whose 10-12-minute talks will present current achievements in peptide and protein research, covering synthesis, structural studies, and biological investigations.

The Foundation supports Hungarian peptide and protein research, especially conference participation, scholarships, and the scientific progress of young researchers. It was established on the initiative of Dr. Sandor Bajusz and Dr. Kalman Medzihradszky, and is linked to the 25th European Peptide Symposium held in Budapest in 1998.

The planned lectures will pay tribute to the pioneering work of our distinguished chemists and to the establishment of peptide chemistry laboratories in Hungary.
